Yamba's leadership believes that education is wealth and such ideology has inspired the non-profit leaders to focus on creating the possible opportunities for enabling kids in the program enjoy their right to education. We thank God that we have been able to solicit money for purchasing the school bags for kids to use in their education. We have distributed over
